Based on information provided by the investors, this third edition was compiled by the AMT coordinator and contains the profiles of 34 investors active in Africa. Specifically designed for African microfinance institutions, the booklet contains all the information and contact details for each investor listed: mission, funding criteria, type of products offered and benefits of doing business with them are also included. Additionally, contact details of AMT's 47 member MFIs, 4 member rating agencies and 6 associate members are also listed.
